

DAY 11 – THE FIRE AND THE RAIN

Scripture: 1 Kings 18

Devotion: Fire purifies; rain restores. Sometimes God burns away what hinders us before He brings refreshing.

Prayer: “Lord, purify me and refresh me. Remove what hinders and restore what’s dry.”

Declaration: God is cleansing and restoring me.

DAY 12 – RESTORE THE YEARS

Scripture: Joel 2:23-25

Devotion: God restores what was stolen or wasted. He redeems seasons we thought were gone forever.

Prayer: “Restore what has been lost, broken, or delayed. Redeem my time, Lord.”

Declaration: God restores what was lost.

DAY 13 – MAKE ME A VESSEL

Scripture: 2 Timothy 2:21

Devotion: God uses vessels that are clean, surrendered, and available. Fasting cleans the vessel so the Spirit can flow freely.

Prayer: “Lord, refine me and make me a vessel ready for Your purposes.”

Declaration: Make me usable, Lord.

DAY 14 – WASH ME WITH YOUR WORD

Scripture: Ephesians 5:26

Devotion: Scripture washes away lies and confusion. It strengthens faith and realigns our thinking.

Prayer: “Wash my mind with Your Word. Replace fear with faith and confusion with clarity.”

Declaration: I am washed by the Word.

DAY 15 – LATTER RAIN

Scripture: Joel 2:19, 23, 28

Devotion: Joel declared that God would send “the latter rain” – a renewed outpouring after a season of lack. God restores what weariness tried to take. As you continue this fast, expect fresh strength and renewed passion to rise in you.

Prayer: “Lord, send the latter rain. Refresh my spirit and strengthen me again.”

Declaration: The latter rain is falling.

DAY 16 – A SOFTENED HEART

Scripture: Ezekiel 36:26

Devotion: God promises to replace a hardened heart with a tender and responsive one. Fasting helps us notice where we’ve grown cold or guarded, inviting Him to soften and heal those places.

Declaration: God is softening my heart.

DAY 17 – REVIVAL IN OUR CHURCH

Scripture: Acts 2

Devotion: Revival came to the early believers when they gathered with hunger, unity, and expectation. When we seek God together, He moves among us with power that transforms lives.

Prayer: “Holy Spirit, move in our church. Stir hunger, unity, and revival. Fill me with the baptism of Holy Spirit like in Acts 2.”

Declaration: Our church is a well of revival.

DAY 18 – REVIVAL IN OUR CITY

Scripture: Jonah 3

Devotion: God changed an entire city when hearts humbled themselves before Him. He loves our city and desires to bring hope, healing, and awakening to every home and neighborhood.

Prayer: “Lord, awaken our city. Bring healing and salvation to Fort Payne.”

Declaration: Our city will see revival.

DAY 19 – REVIVAL IN OUR NATION

Scripture: Psalm 33:12

Devotion: God blesses a nation that turns toward Him. Even in challenging times, He is able to stir hearts, bring unity, and spark spiritual renewal across the land.

Prayer: “God, revive our nation. Turn hearts back to You across America. Start in me Holy Spirit.”

Declaration: God, revive our nation.

DAY 20 – ASK FOR RAIN

Scripture: Zechariah 10:1

Devotion: God invites His people to boldly ask for rain. Prayer is not passive – it is faith-filled expectation that God will move. Today, lift your voice with confidence as you seek His presence.

Prayer: “Lord, we ask for Your rain. Pour out refreshing and breakthrough.”

Declaration: Lord, we ask for rain.


DAY 21 – THE RAIN IS HERE

Scripture: 1 Kings 18:41

Devotion: Elijah heard the sound of rain before evidence appeared. Faith sees God moving even before the breakthrough arrives. Declare today that God has already begun to pour out His Spirit.

Prayer: “Thank You, Lord, for what You are pouring out. I receive Your rain. LET IT RAIN.”

Declaration: The rain is here.

★ WHAT IS FASTING?

Fasting is the intentional denial of something physical for the purpose of pursuing something spiritual.

It helps quiet our flesh and amplify our spiritual sensitivity so we can hear God more clearly.

Fasting does not move God toward us – it moves us toward God.

Fasting creates:

- Hunger for His presence
- Clarity in prayer
- Breakthrough in difficult areas
- Sensitivity to the Holy Spirit
- A heart ready for God to send the rain

★ FASTING TIPS

- Drink water often
- Limit or remove social media
- Reduce noise and distractions
- Replace cravings with prayer
- Stay consistent
- Use a journal daily
- When you feel weak → pray more
- Expect spiritual resistance – and push through

DAY 1 – SEND THE RAIN

Scripture: Hosea 6:3

Devotion: Hosea teaches that God "comes like the rain" to those who pursue Him. Rain symbolizes renewal, softening, and cleansing. As you begin this fast, choose to press into God with consistency, trusting Him to refresh what has felt spiritually dry.

Prayer: "Lord, come like the rain. Soften dry places and awaken fresh hunger in me."

Declaration: Lord, come like the rain.

DAY 2 – OPEN THE HEAVENS

Scripture: Isaiah 64:1

Devotion: Isaiah boldly asked God to "tear open the heavens." This reminds us that some breakthroughs require God's supernatural involvement. When we fast, we invite His presence into places we cannot fix on our own.

Prayer: "Father, open the heavens over my life. Bring clarity, strength, and supernatural help."

Declaration: Heaven is opening over me.

DAY 3 – CLEAN HANDS, PURE HEART

Scripture: Psalm 24:3–4

Devotion: God desires both clean hands (actions) and a pure heart (motives). Fasting gives us room to examine what we've allowed in our lives and invite God to cleanse us deeply.

Prayer: "Search me, God. Cleanse my thoughts and purify my heart."

Declaration: God is purifying my heart.

DAY 4 – REVIVE US AGAIN

Scripture: Psalm 85:6

Devotion: Revival begins with honest hunger for God. He restores passion where it has dimmed and brings joy where discouragement has lingered.

Prayer: "Revive my spirit, Lord. Restore my joy and awaken passion again."

Declaration: Revival begins in me.

DAY 5 – HOLY SPIRIT COME

Scripture: Acts 1:8

Devotion: The Holy Spirit empowers us to live boldly and faithfully. We cannot walk in supernatural strength without His presence.

Prayer: "Holy Spirit, fill me afresh. Strengthen me where I'm weak and guide my steps."

Declaration: I am empowered by the Spirit.

DAY 6 – BREAK UP THE FALLOW GROUND

Scripture: Jeremiah 4:3

Devotion: God calls us to break up hardened areas so His Word can take root. This often means confronting avoided hurts, disappointments, or fears.

Prayer: "Lord, soften every hardened place in me. Uproot what doesn't belong."

Declaration: My heart is becoming good soil.

DAY 7 – RAIN ON MY HOME

Scripture: Joshua 24:15

Devotion: Spiritual rain starts at home—through peace, unity, and the atmosphere we cultivate. Invite God's presence into your relationships and routines.

Prayer: "God, let Your presence fill my home with unity, peace, and covering."

Declaration: My home is blessed.

DAY 8 – HEAL OUR LAND

Scripture: 2 Chronicles 7:14

Devotion: Personal repentance leads to public revival. God responds to humble hearts and obedient lives.

Prayer: "Lord, heal our land. Bring restoration, unity, and revival to our city."

Declaration: God is healing our land.

DAY 9 – SEND WORKERS

Scripture: Matthew 9:37–38

Devotion: The harvest is ready, but workers are few. Fasting aligns our hearts with God's mission and opens our eyes to people around us.

Prayer: "Lord, send workers—and let me be one. Give me compassion and courage."

Declaration: I am part of the harvest.

DAY 10 – THY KINGDOM COME

Scripture: Matthew 6:10

Devotion: Fasting invites God's Kingdom to shape our decisions, relationships, and priorities. Surrender creates alignment.

Prayer: "Father, bring Your Kingdom into every part of my life."

Declaration: Your Kingdom come.
